FlexEnterprise elevates any proximity format to a new level of security with the addition of unique passwords in both the cards and readers. There are over 40 billion unique passwords from which you can choose!

- Use a password up to 30-bits in length to enhance the security between card and reader. The password enhances security by eliminating the possibility of duplicating card numbers of other companies who use open industry standard formats such as 26-bit Wiegand.
- Add a password to formats currently in use to further enhance security.
- Offer end-users card numbers that are unique to their organization. The addition of a password increases worldwide security. Use the same password for cards and readers connected to any access control hardware / software supplied by any systems' integrator.

With the FlexEnterprise Program, proximity formats are encrypted using a scrambled algorithm and key, and are password-enabled either at the INDALA factory or by using the FlexPass[™] ProxSmith[™] Programmer. The secure format is then encoded onto the card and reader.

The addition of a password does not impact the compatibility of the card ID and reader communication with existing control panels and databases. After verifying the password from the card, the reader passes through the original Wiegand data recognized by the control panel.

A closely monitored authorization process is used to control format security. Individuals must be authorized to order cards and readers, and each new order must be accompanied by a new authorization form.
